

Established in 2009, we are a dynamic, international ministry, touching the nations through uncompromising teaching of the Word, prayer, small groups, conferences and more, under the leadership of Archbishop Nicholas Duncan-Williams, Bishop Dr. Kibby Otoo, and branch pastor, Pastor Lenita Reeves. We are proud of Pastor Cephas Reeves, who is serving instrumentally in planting a new branch in Monrovia, Liberia.

Since our inception in 2009, we have been moving toward our vision by:

- Joining with Hope Village to conduct summer camp
- Donating clothes and food to the community
- Providing free resume writing, job interviewing, entrepreneurship, parenting, and addiction counseling seminars
- Establishing the Dominion
 Development Center (DDC) as
 a separate entity for non profit purposes

And we want to fully operationalize the Dominion Development Center (DDC) as a referral and empowerment center, offering a range of services including:

- A community food bank (in partnership with the Maryland Food Bank, which is just 1 exit away from our church)
- Regular resume and interviewing workshops
- Free clothing for job interviews
- After school and tutoring services for the community
- · A community daycare
- A scholarship fund for collegebound high school seniors















What We Believe

THE WORD: The Bible is given by the inspiration of God and is the only sufficient, certain, and authoritative rule of all-saving knowledge, faith, and obedience. (II Tim 3:16, Ps 119:9-11)

GOD: There is one God revealed to us as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, each with distinct attributes. To God alone do all creatures owe the highest reverence, love, and obedience. (Ex 20: 1-6, Matt 28: 19, II Corinthians 13:14)

JESUS: Jesus Christ is the Son and is divinely appointed as mediator between God and man. He died, was buried, arose on the third day, ascended into heaven, and sits at the right hand of God interceding for us. (I Tim 2:5, Rom 8:34)

HOLY SPIRIT: The indwelling of the Holy Spirit is vital for understanding the Word, for power to witness, and for spiritual fruit in the life of the believer. (Gal 5:22, Acts 4:31, John 16: 13-14)

SALVATION: Regeneration is a change of heart by the Holy Spirit to a life of holiness, freely given by repentance and acceptance of Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior.

BAPTISM: Water baptism by immersion is an ordinance of the church, obligatory upon every believer. (I Peter 3:20-22, Mark 16: 16) Infants and children may be dedicated to the Lord, but they will not be baptized in water.

FRUITFULNESS: The continual practice of the spiritual disciplines (prayer, fasting, Bible Study, and worship) is necessary for Christian growth and fruitfulness. (CoI 4:2, Josh 1:8, 11 Tim 2:15)

THE LOCAL CHURCH: Each believer must be committed to a local assembly for spiritual oversight, accountability, and participation.

THE CHRISTIAN LIFESTYLE: The Christian lifestyle is one of holiness. It requires putting to death the old sinful and worldly nature and putting on the holy and godly nature of the new man on a daily basis. (Heb 12:14, Col 3:4-6, Rom 1: 26-27, Gal 5: 16-26).

Action Chapel Baltimore (ACB) began out of Sunday evening Breakthrough Hour services in August of 2009 at the Holiday Inn on Howard Street (downtown Baltimore) and held its first morning service in January 2010 at Hope Village Center on Fayette Avenue. A team of 13 people were commissioned along with Pastor Cephas and Pastor Lenita Reeves to plant the work in Baltimore.

Currently, ACB is growing into a dynamic, international ministry, touching the nations through preaching, prayer, discipleship, teaching, deliverance meetings, and conferences, under the leadership of Senior Pastor, Lenita Reeves.

Action Chapel Baltimore is a branch of Action Churches worldwide, and its parent church, Action Chapel International (ACI) was started in 1979 in Accra, Ghana, and pioneered the charismatic movement in that part of Africa. Currently, ACI has over 100 affiliate churches worldwide. The church is commonly known simply as "Action."

Becoming a Member









The purpose of membership in the local church is to be taught the Word of God, to have a spiritual family to which you belong, to be committed to the work of God, and to be planted firmly so that you can grow spiritually. In Ephesians 4:11 ministry gifts were given so that believers would be perfected and equipped. It is our goal to minister to you in such a way that you will mature in the things of God.

The process of becoming a member of ACB is as follows: One has to make a decision to be a part of the body of Christ.

- If desiring membership, one needs to complete a membership card.
- Member candidates will be contacted and scheduled for a membership class.
- Upon completion of the membership class, the member candidate will receive full rights and privileges of membership along with a membership certificate. If the member is a new convert, they will be enrolled in new converts' class. If not a new convert, the new member will be encouraged to attend adult Sunday school.
- Members will be assigned to a Fellowship group for follow-up.
